## **THE DNC SYSTEM TECHNOLOGIES SHIELD**

**Previously this was the Aradlay Triton Trophy; Ian Ramsay has donated the Shield – thank you Ian.**

Awarded to the best Engineering Model of any class, being a ‘First Attempt’, on display at the annual Australian Association of Live Steamers Convention. Inaugurated 2011.

### **Conditions of Award**

1. Shall be a ‘First Attempt’ at any Engineering type model built within the last ten years of the date of entry. Engineering Type Models shall be, but not necessarily limited to: heat engines of all types; railway locomotives of all types; road vehicles of all types; and aircraft and boats of all types.
2. All models shall be ‘Working Models’ and should be in running order during the Convention. Should the Convention venue not be suitable to demonstrate a model, e.g for a boat, then other evidence of its performance capabilities may be required by the judges.
3. Nominations shall be submitted to the Convention Secretary up until midday on the Friday of the Convention.
4. Entries submitted shall be available for display until 5 pm on the Saturday of the Convention. Builders of entries shall be present at the Saturday evening awards presentation.
5. The presentation of the trophy shall be made by:
  - a) a representative of DNC System Technologies;
  - b) or the President of the AALS or his nominated representative;
  - c) or the winner of the previous year’s Shield.
6. The winner will hold the Shield for twelve months and guarantee to ensure that it is returned for the following Convention.
7. The winner’s name and model type will be inscribed on the Shield in a suitable form, with, if the winner so desires, any cost to be paid from Association Funds.
8. Only members of Affiliated Societies in the Association shall be eligible for entry. There shall be no age limit to the entrant.
