

**Occupational Health and Safety Act 2004
Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007**

EXEMPTION


This exemption from compliance with a provision of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007 is granted by the Victorian WorkCover Authority under regulation 7.2.1 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007:

Persons are exempted from compliance with the provision of Subdivision 1 of Division 7 of Part 3.5 (Plant) of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007, requiring registration in accordance with Part 6.2 (Registration), of the design or alteration of the design of an item of plant specified in Part 1 of Schedule 2, being 'pressure' equipment other than pressure piping', to be registered in accordance with Part 6.2 (Registration) where such specified plant is designed in accordance with the relevant Part of the Australian Miniature Boiler Safety Committee (AMBSC) Boiler Code as stated:

Item of Plant	Relevant Part of the ASMBSC Boiler Code
Copper miniature boilers	Part 1
Steel miniature boilers	Part 2
Sub-miniature boilers	Part 3
Duplex steel miniature boilers	Part 4

In accordance with regulation 7.2.4 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007, in granting this exemption, the Victorian WorkCover Authority is satisfied that the granting of the exemption will result in a level of health and safety with respect to the undertaking of miniature boiler design that is at least equivalent to that which would be achieved by observance of the relevant provision and that the risk associated with the plant is not significant if the exemption is granted.

This exemption starts on and from the day on which this notice is published in the Government Gazette.
